The big donation from Rotary also included two huge agricultural plastic tunnels for growing vegetables as well as another submersible pump which would make life so much easier for us! Tobie Vente and Pieter Bos were organizing the project with great help from Willie, Henry and his wife, Elsje. Maryna Vente must get a special thanks for she managed to keep everyone going with her great cooking! Gerhardt Fourie must also get a special mention for he came all the way from England to do the connection of the solar system as well as many other electrical stuff. Gerhardt, you have become part of the family in such a short time!

Tobie got thirty of the local people to help with the digging of holes and erection of the plastic tunnels. We also had to dig a great big well for housing the submersible pump which had to be lined with bricks and mortar.

A group of 16-mission students all the way from Kabwe, under the leadership of pastor David and his wife, Liz, also came to visit. The students were spreading the Gospel in the village with help from an amazing donation of soccer balls we received just two weeks prior to their visit from Manie du Toit's "Living Ball"-ministry from George, South Africa.

We are also sponsoring fourteen small children from the Kanjanji Project attending the St Josephs Catholic pre-school at Lusu, the other school in our area.

Lastly we also want to congratulate two of our children with their teachers diplomas. Choolwe and William went all the way back to Kitwe were they received their diplomas at a diploma ceremony and while pa and ma could not attend the function we at least have some pictures. They have both been volunteering their services at the two local schools for the past year and many children are benefitting from that. We are very proud of these two boys and we want to thank everyone, involved in the project, yet again, for playing a part in securing a future for these two boys.
