Wish you could see the mighty Zambezi River this time of year! The water level has risen with an unbelievable two metres and will keep on rising till the end of April. It is almost bursting its banks and the real danger is that many vegetable gardens on the banks will be destroyed.

We have just returned from a visit to South Africa and England and I managed to get my insulin and test strips replenished for the next year. It was really great to see all the friends again. While visiting the UK Lourie contracted a sudden very painful condition in the right eye and after several visits to doctors and A & E's the condition was diagnosed as iritis which is an inflammation of the iris part of the eye. Iritis could also lead to loss of sight if it stays untreated. Luckily the problem was addressed before we had to return to Zambia although Lourie will have to see a specialist in SA for a follow up.

Two of our children, Cholwe and Kelvin, both qualified teachers, were looking after the base while we were away. Both of them have mathematics as majors and are teaching at the two local schools while they are waiting for postings.

The two of them did an excellent job of looking after the place. Both are also teaching children who need extra care as well as those who need to redo some subjects in order to get accepted at college. Every kwacha they earn is saved to realise their big dream to see and experience snow somewhere in Europe. Both have planted some vegetable gardens to generate some extra income.

While we were away our little house was struck by lightning during a violent thunder storm. It has

Lourie se sig was alreeds geaffekteer. Gelukkig is die probleem gediagnoseer voordat ons moes terug bosse toe! Lourie sal egter vir 'n opvolgondersoek na SA moet reis.

Twee van ons kinders, Cholwe en Kelvin, wat albei gekwalifiseerde onderwysers is, het die basis bestuur terwyl ons weg was. Albei van hulle het wiskunde as hoofvak en gee onderrig by beide van ons twee plaaslike skole terwyl hulle wag op plasings.

Die twee het hulle voorwaar uitstekend van hul taak gekwy. Albei van hulle gee privaatonderrig aan studente en leerlinge wat matriek wil skryf of wat vakke moet verbeter om kollegetoelating te verkry. Hulle spaar elke eksta kwacha wat hulle verdien om hulle droom te bewaarheid om êrens in Europa te gaan sneeu sien! Beide van hulle het ook ekstra tuine aangelê en mielies geplant om hul inkoste aante vul.
