### Personal and projects

All the schools in Zambia started this week and it was quite an effort to get all the children to where they should be. Fortunately we had Cholwe and Coster, who both finished school last year, to help us with the mad rush and all of the 42 children are now back at school. We even managed to get places at boarding schools for all the older ones except for one who has to repeat his school year so that he would hopefully get better results next year for acceptance to boarding school. The problem is the demand for boarding is so high and the boarding schools are few and far between, and only children with really good averages get accepted.

Two of our older children have now completed their college diplomas. Doreen Kamwenga is now 'n qualified preschool teacher and Lido Samba, is completing the practical part to become a staff nurse. Doreen had lost the sight in one eye in a freak accident when she was much younger and as a result of that the eye now has a greyish appearance, which is very obvious. The aim is now to try and get an appointment for Doreen with an eye specialist in South Africa, to see whether an artificial eye would be an option. A specialist in Pretoria, Dr Harold König, was so kind to agree to have a look into the different options for Doreen.

Below on the right is a picture of the small shop the children erected while we were away with proceeds from their little shop. Lourie is pictured with Mordecai and Cholwe, who is the oldest child at 21 years of age, and his birthday is next week.

### Persoonlik en projekte

Die skole het hierdie week begin en dit was 'n geskarrel van 'n ander wêreld om almal geholpe te kry. Met die hulp van die groter kinders, Coster en Cholwe, het ons nou elkeen van die 42 kinders waar hulle moet wees! Al die groter kinders is nou in kosskole en daar is slegs een van die kinders vir wie ons nie 'n plekkie kon kry nie, maar het die knapie oortuig om die jaar te herhaal sodat hy volgende jaar, hopelik met beter punte, toelating in die kosskool kan kry. Daar is min kosskole in die omgewing en omdat die aanvraag so groot is word net die kinders met regtig goeie gemiddeldes gekies.

Twee van ons oudste kinders het gegraduateer en Doreen Kamwenga is nou 'n voorskoolse onderwyseres en Lido Samba voltooi nou haar prakties in verpleging. Doreen het as kind die sig in een oog verloor in 'n fratsongeluk en as gevolg daarvan het sy nou so 'n vaal ou ogie wat baie opsigtelik is. Ons gaan probeer om vir Doreen by 'n oogspesialis te kry om te hoor wat die kans is op 'n mooi nuwe kunsogie. My oorarts in Pretoria, Dr Harold König, het goedgunstiglik aangebied om Doreen te ondersoek en na die moontlikheid te kyk.

Links onder is die winkeltjie wat die kinders gebou het om ekstra geld mee in te vorder, en hulle het dit met die winste van die winkeltjie gedoen (natuurlik met die hulp van die pastoor – wat die bouwerk behartig het). Lourie staan saam met Mordecai en ons oudste kind, Cholwe, wat volgende week 21 word.

There was even enough money left over to buy every older child a pair of "jean pants", as they call it over here. We are working together with past. Siteleka and his church, and our aim is to try and improve the Sunday school teachings at the church and to help mobilize people for prison- and hospital ministry.

We would be leaving for Kabwe, north of Lusaka, for a few days in the near future, to take four more children to attend the OM Discipleship training. They would be accommodated at the base like before and this would be the third group of people going for discipleship. We want to thank everyone who has made it possible for us to send these children so that the good news of Jesus Christ could be spread throughout the world and change so many people's lives.
