Sy vertrek oor 10-dae terug na Switserland nadat sy drie maande lank vir ons kom help het. Brigitte het so deel geword van die familie dat ons nou al wonder wat ons sonder haar gaan doen. The Zambian school holidays have also started and some of our children came home to lend a helping hand. We also have a work programme for the older boys from the nearby schools and after their tasks have been completed we give them time on the amazing "Reading Rocket" computer program, specially designed for African children, to improve comprehension and computer skills.

You would not believe but our work permits have been sorted now but because the whole process took such a long time we only have six months left on them so it is almost time for renewal again. Luckily we would also be able to import the vehicle on a temporary basis, at a cost, of course.
