Braam de Wet and Jan Schlebush from Potchefstroom in South Africa came to take accurate satellite navigation readings to determine where the water pump and water tank should be placed.

We still have to return to Choma at least once every month to tend to our children on the project and Mordecai, one of our children, joined us when we returned to Barotseland. William and Mordie are still waiting for results of their applications at different teacher's colleges but Cholwe was so fortunate to have accepted at a very good teachers college.

Dit is nou baie warm en droog hier in Zambië met temperature wat elke dag net so raak aan die 40 grade. Elke wolkie word met groot verwagting dopgehou – want miskien is dit die begin van die langverwagte reen!

Projekte en persoonlik

Ons het verlede maand vertel van die stukkie grond wat die induna vir die sendingorganisasie gegee het hier reg op die wal van die Zambezi. Na vele kere se heen en weer na die "kuta" (regspersoon van die chieft), so 'n honderd kilometer van ons af, is die proses om die grond in die naam van OM (Operation Mobilisation) geregistreer te kry nog nie afgehandel nie, maar ons weet God is in beheer en dit sal alles op Sy tyd gebeur. Intussen is ons so positief oor die uitkoms dat ons al druk besig is om stene te maak. Links is Lourie en die seuns besig om te sweet in die hitte. **Stuur asseblief vir ons jou gunsteling bybelversie**, want 'n versie op 'n stukkie papier word in elke steen ingegiet. Braam de Wet en Jan Schlebush van Potchefstroom in S.A. het vir ons akkurate lesings kom neem om te bepaal wat die hoogteverskil gaan wees tussen die waterpomp en watertenk.

Ons moet nog elke maand terug Choma toe om na die kinders op die projek te gaan omsien en Mordecai, een van ons kinders, het saam met ons teruggekeer Barotseland toe. William en Mordie wag nog vir die resultate van hulle aansoeke om onderwys te studeer, en Cholwe was baie gelukkig om 'n plek te kry in 'n baie goeie onderwyskollege.

On the right is Enock who is doing his second year studies in environmental health, Ginder is studying nursing at Macha Hospital and Coster is studying teaching at a college in Kabwe. The plan is that all the older children would come to join us after their exams and Doreen, who finished teaching last year, would also come and run the preschool at the new base. Cholwe is still teaching English at the local primary school and he is such a favourite with the children.

The OM leadership in Kabwe informed us that the first students who need to do rural discipleship will be on their way to us in January already. These missionaries have completed the OM training in Kabwe and are ready for practical missionary work, so we are looking forward to the new base.

We would also like to thank Andre and Ancia Cronje with the amazing amount of money they managed to raise with the Mari-Simon Golf Day which allows us to start building the new base right away.
