Hier regs bo is almal, nadat hulle skoon gewas en gepoleer is.

Op dieselfde trant het ek besluit om die Woensdag tydens die babadag, al die babas te bad en ook skoon kleertjies en nuwe doeke aan te trek. Die skooldogters het gehelp en dit was pandemonium! Projects

The holiday project with 25 children around, was very hectic and it took a great deal of energy to keep everyone occupied. Fortunately, we had two sets of two-way radio's (donated by friends) on site to help ease the communication and organisation. Mike, the preschool teacher, was mainly in charge of organising all the children and he even had time in-between to teach computer skills to those who were interested.

On the last day of the holiday, we asked the children to bring along a clean set of clothes. While their dirty clothes were being washed in our little washing machine, each of the children got a chance to take a warm shower. This was a first for most of them and what an experience! We also supplied them with deodorants and perfume as well as the use of some nail clippers, which they had never seen before. Oh, how they enjoyed all of this – wish you could see it!

We did the same on the Wednesday for the babies on the baby feeding programme. With the help of the older girls we bathed all the babies in small tubs with warm water, dusted them with baby powder and dressed them with clean clothes and nappies. What chaos that created! At one stage, all 25 of them were crying at the same time. They smelled so nice afterwards! Even the smallest one, three weeks old, was spotless in her new change of clothes. (Her mom died of AIDS just after her birth.)

During the last week of the school holidays I taught some of the girls some basic needlework. On the photo on the next page, Ellen and Nicole are very proud showing off of the sling bags they have made.
