Ons het, nadat Milo deur 'n krokodil gebyt is, weereens besef dat ons respek moet hê vir wilde Afrika, so swem in die vol rivier is nie nou 'n opsie nie.

Projekte en persoonlik

Ons het verlede week teruggekeer vanaf 'n blitsbesoek van SA, omdat Lourie se pa 'n 2e heupvervanging sou kry en ook sy 80e verjaarsdag in die hospitaal sou vier. Maar soos 'n vorige keer, is hy wel opgeneem, en toe vind hulle uit dat daar 'n ander ernstige probleem is, en kon dus nie opereer nie. Ons kon darem sy 80e verjaardag vier, voordat hy weer opgeneem is. Hy is tans in die hoë sorg eenheid op 'n nierdialise masjien en ons bid dat hy volkome sal herstel, want hy is nog so jonk van gees. Saterdag het malaria weer 'n klein lewetjie geëis; ons het die onstellende nuus gekry dat die pastoor van die kerkie waarvan ons deel is, se middelste seuntjie aan malaria oorlede is. Kelvin en Benjamin het toe Sondag die begrafnisdiens gelei. Dit was baie hartseer.

Ons tydjie in SA was baie gejaagd en jammer dat ons nie by almal 'n draai kon maak nie, maar julle is baie welkom om by ons te kom kuier! 'n Spesiale woord van dank aan die AGS Siongemeente van Parys, Suid Afrika, vir hulle insameling tydens die diens wat meer as ons petrolgeld gedek het! Ook baie dankie aan julle vir die bereidwilligheid om vir jong Benjamin (die Zambiese sendeling) finansiëel te ondersteun. Met die geldjies wil hy eerstens 'n fiets aanskaf want hy loop baie kilometers met die voet na die villages om die goeie nuus van Jesus te verkondig.

During our visit to South Africa we mentioned to some friends that we are looking for an architect to help us with building plans for the new piece of land. Tobie and Maryna Vente introduced us to their daughter Anushka who is an architect and her boss, listen to this, is Lodewyk Welgemoed, also an architect who had been a member of the South African Congregation in England, with us, for many years. (He was with us on the SAC church board for many years, as well as a cell group leader!) How amazing is our God!

We really need to get started with the building project because Nina Fishing Camp was sold to a Zambian business man so we are not sure what our future holds at Nina.
