### **Persoonlik en projekte:**

Soos baie van julle weet, het die projek by Kanjanji baie gegroei en ons het Desember verlede jaar by 'n groot sendingorganisasie, OM. (Operation Mobilisation) aangesluit.

ProChristo, ook 'n sendingorganisasie, het intussen saamgesmelt met OM, wat sendelinge regoor die wêreld het. Vir die wat nie weet nie, ProChristo het verlede jaar gehelp met die invoer van die krat vanaf Engeland, geborg deur ons tuisgemeente, die S.A. Gemeente in London.

OM. sal dan ook wêreldwye blootstelling aan Kanjanji kan gee asook help met die identifisering en plasing van ander sendelinge om met die projek op Kanjanji te help. Omdat OM. as sendingorganisasie belastingvoordele in Zambië geniet, behoort die invoer van goedere vir Kanjanji minder van 'n probleem in die toekoms te wees. Die hele projek sal dan ook 'n platvorm wees vir internasionale spanne om uitreike, diens, ens te kom doen en ons sal van al OM. se kennis en ondervinding in die sendingveld gebruik kan maak.

Ons het groot planne vir Kanjanji en buiten die skool, kan ons selfs in die toekoms dink aan 'n Bybelopleidingskollege, en 'n kliniek (selfs 'n hospitaal!) ensomeer.

That is hello in "Bemba", one of the 72 different languages in Zambia and the language spoken in this part of the country where we are doing the OM/ProChristo training at the moment.

We are in a town called, Kabwe, which is north of Lusaka, near the famous Copper Belt province. Some of the other languages spoken in this area are Lozi and Chichewa.

### **Personal and projects:**

As you would know the project at Kanjanji has grown and expanded so much now, that we have decided to join OM (Operation Mobilisation) at the end of last year. OM. is one of the biggest mission organisations in the world with missionaries in many countries all over the world.

ProChristo, another mission organisation, which helped us with the importation of the container from the S.A. Congregation in England, has merged with OM. and will be known as OM. in the future.

Through OM, Kanjanji will get exposure right across the world and they will also help with identifying missionaries to come and help at Kanjanji. As a mission organisation, OM. also gets tax benefits in Zambia so the importation of any goods for Kanjanji would hopefully be much less of a problem in the future and could also be done free of tax. Kanjanji would also serve as a springboard for different groups from all over the world to come and do outreaches into the community and OM's knowledge and years of experience will also be of great value.

Let me tell you, we have big plans for Kanjanji. Apart from the school we could also look into the possibility of a Bible College as well as a clinic (or even a hospital!) at some stage.

Die klein dogtertjie met die 6 vingers en tone, is nou gesond en besoek ons gereeld. Klein Godwin is nou al meer as 3 maande oud en 'n sterk baba. Die verpleegster, Caroline Green van Choma staan in vir ons met die kinderprogramme.
