Thank you to everyone who has contributed towards blankets and bedding for the children. There are so many who do not have the same privileges that we have. Some of the children do not want to remove the plastic cover from their mattresses; they feel it would stay new for much longer!

Projects and personal:

In the previous newsletter we mentioned that Monique Terblanche came to visit all the way from Ashford, in the south of England. While Monique was experiencing all the hair-raising adventures, which Livingstone has to offer, we bumped into Anton from South Africa who is cycling all the way from Cape Town to London. Anton quit his job and this epic journey of 17 000km is going to take at least a year to complete. Anton was also the first guy ever who dared to do the bungi-jump at the Falls with his bicycle, believe it or not. (picture on the right) Anton is distributing 400 bicycles, which had been donated by a charity in Switzerland, to the most needy in different parts of Africa. Anton also met some of our children and encouraged them with the words to "live their dream". He suggested they put a picture of their dream in their bibles so they do not stop dreaming about it. We had to find old magazines so they would get pictures of their dreams like becoming a pilot, medical doctor etc. On the picture is Anton playing football with a ball made from tightly rolled used plastic bags.

We also treated Anton to a traditional meal out in the village and when we got back to Kanjanji we found that the power was down. Only the next morning did we find that a snake has caused the short circuit outside on the transformer.

Projekte en persoonlik:

In die vorige nuusbrief het ons vertel van Monique Terblanche wie vir ons kom kuier het al die pad van Ashford, in die suide van Engeland. Terwyl Monique al die avonture in Livingstone beleef het, het ons vir Anton van Suid Afrika raak geloop, wat al die pad van Kaapstad tot in London met sy fiets aandurf. Anton het sy werk bedank en vermoed die tog van 17 000km gaan sowat 'n jaar neem. Anton het by die Vic Falls met sy fiets en al gebungi-jump! Links is 'n foto... dit was blykbaar 'n heel eerste by die valle. Anton is verbonde aan 'n liefdadigheidorganisasie genaamd HOPE. Hulle het 400 fietse uit Switserland gekry en doneer dit aan weeskinders regdeur Afrika. Anton het dus baie opgewonde van ons kinders ontmoet en hulle bemoedig met die woorde "live your dream". Hy het ook vir hulle gesê om te probeer om 'n foto te kry van dit waar oor hulle droom, en dit in hul Bybel te sit en nooit op te hou droom daar oor nie. Ek moes toe vir sommige van hulle tydskrifte gee oor vliegtoeie, oor die mediese beroep, ens. Links is Anton saam met van die kinders waarmee hy ook agterna 'n sokkerwedstryd gespeel het met 'n bal gemaak van styf opgerolde plastieksakke.

Ons het ook vir Anton vir 'n ete in ons Village restaurant geneem, en die aand by Kanjanji oornag. Met ons aankoms, was die krag af. Eers die volgende oggend het Lourie-hulle agtergekom dat 'n slang die kortsluiting voorsaak het by die transformator!
