No, we still do not have permanent accommodation because we are still looking after the fishing camp till the new owner takes up residence.

We have just returned from our annual visit to England and please allow us to thank everyone again for the wonderful time we had over there. We had such an amazing time with our brothers and sisters and friends and it was with a bit of sadness that we left England. Thank you so much to everyone who contributed to make this an unforgettable time for us. There are almost too many names to mention and so many things done for us, like all the nice meals at your homes, eating out, your homes which were open to us, the small car, storage for our stuff, donations, blood glucose test strips, DVD's and CD's for teaching, clothes for skiing, taking us to-and-fro, a camera, clothes for the orphans and to British Airways for allowing us 10 extra suitcases at no extra cost! A special thanks go to Andre and Christelle from Calgary who carried the cost for five days of skiing and for the unforgettable time we spent with you!

Benjamin, the young Zambian missionary, and Kelvin, one of our children, had been looking after the fishing camp while we were away and they also used the time well to mould more bricks for our building project. Kelvin got his grade-12 results on Friday and we are very proud of his one distinction as well as three near distinctions. Kelvin came to us five years ago with very poor results and a bleak future, looking for help and support.

Dit was so lekker om weer saam met broers en susters en vriende te kuier dat dit eintlik moeilik was om terug te keer Afrika toe, as dit nie vir ons kinders en natuurlik Milo, die hondjie was nie! Daar was soveel lekker, dat dit onmoontlik is om almal se name te noem! Nogmaals baie dankie aan almal vir die byeenkomste wat gerêel is, lekker kos by julle huise, uiteet, kuier, julle deure wat vir ons oop was, die karretjie, stoorplek, donasies, bloedsuiker-stokkies, DVD's en CD's vir opleiding, ski-klere, op-en-af-ry, 'n kamera, klere vir die kinders en selfs aan British Airways wat dit vir ons moontlik gemaak het om 10 ekstra tasse bagasie sonder enige koste saam te bring. Ook 'n baie spesiale dankie aan Andre en Christelle van Calgary wat die koste gedra het vir 5-dae se heerlike ski en die onvergeetlike tyd saam met julle!

Benjamin, die jong sendeling, en Kelvin, een van ons kinders, het na die kamp omgesien terwyl ons weg was en het fluks aangehou stene maak in ons afwesigheid. Kelvin het sy matriekuitslae Vrydag ontvang en ons is baie trots op hom! Hy het 1 onderskeiding behaal en 3 ander onderskeidings net-net gemis. Wonderlik vir 'n weeskind wat vyf jaar gelede by ons om hulp kom aanklop het met powere uitslae en geen ondersteuning nie.

Kelvin wants to become a lawyer to help the poor communities in Zambia.

Our little dog, Milo, is recovering well after she was badly bitten by a crocodile but it seems that she did not have a big enough scare because she is already chasing monitor lizards around in the reeds along the river. The water level is still rising steadily and it is so high now that our little shack is totally surrounded by water and the moulded bricks are also sitting in water. The other day we also struggled to get our little trailer to dry land on the other side. Although the river is so full at the moment it is very dry in our area since it has not rained for the past fortnight and the chances of a good maize harvest are dwindling by the day. Remember most of the locals are subsistence farmers so they rely on a good maize harvest to feed the family for the next year.
