We already knew that most of them would only have a plastic bag in which to pack their clothes, so we bought small rucksacks for each of them at the local store. We also put a towel, soap, toothbrush, tooth paste and some under wear in each bag, and Mary, the pastor's wife offered to bake 50 sweet cakes for the road. We managed to hire a small minibus at a good rate and off we went on this exciting trip. Outside of Livingstone, on the way to Crocodile Creek, we saw some giraffe next to the road and for most of them that was the first time ever. The children were speechless when we arrived at Crocodile Creek and they saw the mighty Zambezi River for the first time. Late afternoon Paul Oosthuizen, the neighbour, sprung a surprise on all the children by taking them on his boat around the island to see a huge crocodile and a pod of hippopotami's. They were totally awestruck!

Early Saturday morning we left for the Falls, and with the Zambezi River in full flood at the moment, what an awesome sight that was. We had hamburgers for lunch at the Zambezi Sun Hotel and we showed the movie, "The Passion of Christ" afterwards and we want to thank the manager, Roelf du Toit and everyone else for everything they had done to make this an unforgettable trip for each and every child.

Ek en Lourie het toe alreeds geweet dat die weeskinders plastiessakkies sal gebruik om hul besittinkies in te sit en het 14 rugsakke gaan koop by die plaaslike skoenwinkel. Ons het ook vir elkeen 'n handoek, seep, tandeborsel, tandepasta en onderklere ingesit. Mary, die pastoor se vrou, het vir padkos gesorg en 50 "sweet cakes" geskenk. Ons kon toe ook bekostig om 'n plaaslike minibussie te huur vir die naweek, So het ons die pad al singende aangepak tot in Livingstone waar 3 van ons studente by ons aangesluit het. Oppad na Crocodile Creek, buite Livingstone, het ons die eerste wilde diere teëgekom. 'n Paar pragtige kameelperde het reg langs die pad gestaan en al die kinders was uit hulle velle!
