Projekte en persoonlik

Hier by ons het die nuwe jaar vinnig begin. Ek en Lourie het net na Nuwejaar teruggekeer van ons besoek aan SA na 'n baie droëe Zambië.

Daar het geen reën vir byna 4 weke geval nie en, om alles te kroon, het die weerlig weereens die hooflyn getref en selfs die beskermingsmeganismes wat in plek was vir hierdie tipe van gebeurlikheid, uitgebrand. Nodeloos om te sê die boorgatpomp is toe ook getref en Kanjanji was sonder water gelaat vir die hele warm Desember! Die mielies was dus amper 'n maand sonder water in hierdie verswelgende hitte en dit gaan natuurlik 'n swak oes tot gevolg hê. Die ergste is dat die plaaslike gemeenskap uit die aard van die saak ook geen oes gaan hê nie en dit beteken dat daar vroeër as gewoonlik hongersnood gaan wees.

We here at Kanjanji would like to wish you a very happy and prosperous 2010. May you be blessed and may all your dreams come true!

Lourie and I travelled to South Africa at the beginning of December for a meeting with Operation Mobilization (OM), one of the largest mission organisations in the world. As you probably know, we do not have any back-up here in Zambia and if anything happens, there will be nobody to take over. OM will confer with all the parties involved, like the local church and the Chief and also work closely with the community.

The Canadian church's 5 year term of involvement to which they committed themselves comes to an end next year and we therefore would like to get more permanent structures in place for the orphanage.

Projects and personal

The new year started off at a very hectic pace. When we arrived back from our trip to South Africa, we were met by severe drought after no rain was recorded for almost 4 weeks.

To top it all, lightning had struck again and the borehole pump had been destroyed in the event, despite all the lightning arresters that were installed. Kanjanji was left without water for the whole of December and with no rain around you can just imagine what the maize harvest is going to be like. What is even more heartbreaking is the fact that the crops planted by the local community would also have been affected by the drought and food shortages are going to be a problem much earlier.

We now realise and appreciate so much more how blessed you are if you have the ways and means to walk into a supermarket and buy even just the basic necessities.

Fortunately, we still have a good supply of maize from the
